Building

CS to contact coastline windows about the front door locks, there was discussion about a phone line and the proposed works to the lane it was agreed to go for the best solution as we have the cash. CS waiting for quotes and then will approach Mr Parker for a donation.

May Queen

There was discussion regarding the use of the folding tables and chairs and possible damage to them on the field - CS has donated the old wooden trestle tables, (Spencers to collect from Rew Street) so it will only be the folding chairs that will be needed, and they were bought for outside use.

Marie and Elaine have agreed to take part from 12 onwards and WP and CS will be there from about 11 a.m - others will come as and when or supply cakes.
